1. General (Times 11, bold)

Contributed papers must be in English and should report previously unpublished work. The authors can select a total length, including figures and references, of one or two A4 format pages. The authors are responsible for the content and style of the contribution. No editing or re-typing will be carried out by the Conference organisers. The contributions will be reproduced without reduction or modification. Contributed papers which do not conform to the format described below may be rejected. It is recommended to submit the paper in electronic form at the e-mail address:

The submitted file must be a Portable Document Format (PDF) or Rich Text File (RTF) document. In case you are not able to provide an electronic file as described here above, you are kindly requested to send the paper (original and two copies) at the following address:

Since paper abstracts will be reproduced (camera ready), they should be printed on separate sheets, not attached to each other, and should be shipped in such a way that they would arrive in good order.
Contribution submitted by fax cannot be accepted!

All contributed papers will be refereed by the International Scientific Committee (ISC). Based on their scientific quality, they may be rejected by the ISC, that also will select about 16 of them for a 15 minutes oral presentation. The book of the accepted contributions will be distributed to the participants at the conference site. No publication will occur, unless the registration fee, for at least one of the authors, is received before 15 July 2004.

2. Recommendations for the text

2.1. Format

The abstract should be typewritten for A4 format paper, one or two pages for invited and contributed papers, with Times New Roman font at two columns. Margins are:

Top, Bottom: 2.5 cm; Left and Right : 2 cm
(If **US letter** format is used, set Right: 2.6 cm)
Distance between columns: 0.5 cm

Fonts must be:

Title: Times 14, Bold, centred
Authors names: Times 12, normal, centred
Affiliations: Times 10, Italic, centred
Main text: Times 11, justified in left and right
Figure caption: Times 10, normal

Major headings (Times 11, bold) and subheadings (Times 10, bold) are placed flush on the left-hand margin on a separate line.

2.2. Miscellaneous

The topic number (according to the Scientific Programme) must be written on specified case on the top right and corner of the first page.

2.3. Figures and equations

Papers may include figures. A caption should be attached to each figure. Equation numbers must be in parentheses and place flush with right-hand margin of the column. The pages must not be numbered.

3. References

List and number all references at the end of the paper. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number between brackets as shown at the end of this sentence [1].
